One of the items in the agenda of the GA in Cluj-Napoca will be, according to the Statutes, the election of the President and Vice-President of the Association for the next two years. Therefore, a call for candidacies for the two positions is now launched. The candidacies should be made known to the President (<u>diego.lopresti@dic.unipi.it</u>) with copy to the General Secretary (<u>manoliu@utcb.ro</u>) by 29th September 2016.

Please, complete the Form by 15th September 2016 at latest, enabling us to know who will attend the General Assembly.
